TO RESPOND IN FAITH

*AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

(from "A Brief Statement of Faith")

Elder David Greene: In whom do you trust?

Elder David Greene: In whom do you trust?

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. Amen.
